Motions

Round 1

To achieve equitable territorial development,
This House (TH) prefers to grant benefits and
incentives to groups that practice illegal
mining for its formalization instead of
sanctioning them with the current measures
(the Penal Code establishes custodial sentences
and fines for illegal mining exploration).

Round 2:

TH would have preferred that the management of the five (5) research lines of the Global Education Pact had been entrusted to different higher education centers instead of entrusting them to Jesuit universities.

Round 3

This House Believes That (THBT) the monitoring of progress and fulfillment of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) should be carried out by specialized non-governmental organizations instead of public governmental institutions.

Round 4

TH supports the creation of a trust financed by practitioners of the Catholic Church for the development of training programs for the implementation of the Global Education Pact in public and private educational communities.

Round 5

By 2030, and assuming it were possible, TH, being the international community, would sanction countries for their omissions in the accomplishment of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Round 6
